Heavenly Father, we pray for the souls of the departed. Particularly today we pray for the soul of Maurice Edwards, and ask for your blessing to support Cordie and her family, left here to mourn his passing.

"Lord, you will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain, **any** more."

Heavenly Father, we pray most earnestly for inner personal peace. Jesus commanded us to, "*love one another*", but before we can truly love others, we need to learn to love ourselves, just as we are, with all our imperfections and shortcomings, our longings and our regrets.
